Purpose of the course

The purpose of this short course will address to some extent the urgent need for applied nematology in agro-companies, research institutions and the broader farmer community. The course is designed to equip attendees with essential knowledge of the nature and extent of damage caused by plant-parasitic nematodes in agri- and horticulture. A useful by-product of the course, due to the incorporation of expertise from various outside institutions, is that attendees will have a greater perspective of the size and scope of the subject area, as well as larger career-networking options.
